### RECRUITING PARENTS TO SERVE AS EESAC MEMBERS

DFE is looking for new members to join the 2015-2016 Educational Excellence School Advisory Council (EESAC). The group meets four to six times a year on Wednesdays at 2:15 p.m. for approximately an hour to discuss important issues, such as the School Improvement Plan. If you are interested in joining, please complete/sign the **EESAC** form that will be sent home, including a brief personal/professional background paragraph. The form must be returned to your child's teacher by **Friday, September 18th**. In the event that responses exceed the number of vacant council seats, your biography paragraph will be shared with all parents who will then vote for the new members.

**Closed Campus** Parents may not accompany their child past the school entrance gate during morning drop off. This is for the safety and protection of our students. If you must speak with a teacher please send the teacher an email or make an appointment to have a parent conference with the teacher. Pre-K parents may walk their children to the classroom with the designated Pre-K pass.

**Uniform Policy** David Fairchild Elementary is a mandatory uniform school. All students are required to wear the school uniform. This uniform consists of: red polo shirt (collar with three buttons) or PTA T-shirt and khaki pants, skorts, or jumpers. All footwear must be a closed shoe or sneaker style, no opened-toed shoes and no sandals. Special event T-shirts, such as Field Day shirts can be worn only during the event and not as a part of their regular uniform.

**Twiglet Bank** Our **red caboose** on campus (called the Twiglet Bank) is an actual Bank of the First National Bank of South Miami. Our fifth grade students operate this bank every Wednesday from 1:50 p.m. until 3:00 p.m. Your child can deposit his/her money into a savings account or open a new savings account. **Lunch Bunch** It is a special reading program at DFE for students in **Pre-K through 2<sup>nd</sup> grade**.
